Solid core of fruit, with layers of chocolate, coffee and berry flavours. Full rich with velvety tannins and a long chewy finish | £48.00 |

With an elegant structure, this wine has aromas of bramble, sandalwood and pencil lead, is medium bodied, and firm tannins | £50.00 |
